WOTC Administrators to Release 2007 Certifications

The US Department of Labor has notified state agencies that they can begin issuing WOTC certifications for employees hired since the beginning of 2007.

WOTC Extension Moved to a New Bill

WOTC extension and program enhancements have been removed from the Small Business Tax Relief Act of 2007 due to issues between the House and Senate tax writing committees.

The provisions are now in a supplemental war spending bill that includes language for a date-certain Iraq withdrawal.

First Advantage expects it to be a challenge for Congress to pass this bill as it's currently written due to the Iraq withdrawal timeline as well as the threat of a Presidential veto.

We will continue to work with supporters when Congress returns from recess next week. By including WOTC and other tax concessions in this spending bill, supporters are continuing to build a strong foundation for WOTC provisions.
