TransUnion to Increase Credit and Social Security Search Fees

In order to offset increased costs of doing business created by compliance standards for the Fair and Accurate Credit Transactions Act (FACT Act), Trans Union is increasing their rates to all vendors. As a result, First Advantage finds it necessary to also increase the rate we charge our clients for Trans Union Credit and Social Security Searches. Effective September 1, 2004 all Trans Union transactions will increase \$.25. We would like to remind you that you have the option to order Credit and Social Security Searches through Experian at the current rate. There are no plans at this time to increase Experian products.
